- Position: Pollution Prevention and Energy Specialist, Pollution Prevention Institute, Engineering Extension
- Location: Engineering Extension Programs

- Appointment: One to two positions up to 1.0 F.T.E. are available and subject to the continuing availability of funds through renewal of annual contracts with state and/or federal agencies.
- Starting Date: April 30, 2007, preferred.
- Responsibilities: Engineering Extension Programs, which includes the Pollution Prevention Institute, seeks specialists to work in pollution prevention, energy conservation, and renewable energy. PPI administers the Kansas Small Business Environmental Assistance Program, which provides environmental technical assistance to businesses in Kansas. Specialists will spend the majority of their time providing air-focused environmental compliance and pollution prevention technical assistance through on-site facility visits, hotline calls, and presentations at workshops and training seminars. Specialists will also provide technical assistance and educational outreach concerning energy conservation and renewable energy. Other duties include responding to and writing grant proposals for continued funding; performing applied research in energy conservation and renewable energy; participating in networking opportunities with other assistance providers locally and nationally; and promoting Engineering Extension, PPI, and the Kansas Small Business Environmental Assistance Program, and other programs to appropriate audiences and stakeholders.
- Qualifications: B.S. or B.A. required, in an engineering or science-related discipline. Experience with air-quality regulations, energy issues, and proposal writing desired. Demonstrated written and oral communication skills; computer skills should include expertise with MS Word, Excel, PowerPoint, and use of the Internet. Candidates should be self-directed and motivated. Minimum of one-year experience working in an industrial or environmental education program preferred.
