- Letter sent to facility if no issues found
- Memo sent to Topeka if issues found

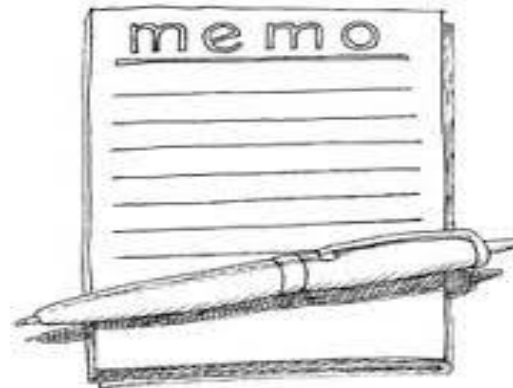


Letter to facility-

-At the time of inspection, the site appeared to be in compliance with the Kansas Air Quality Regulations and your permit. The results of this inspection were based upon determinations which could be made at the facility during the inspection. Compliance with additional requirements of the Kansas Air Quality Regulations which may apply to the facility may be determined after review by our Topeka office.

Memo to Topeka...

- Inspector wants clarification
- Possible violation was found
- Permit and regulation review
- May need guidance from Region VII EPA



More info needed

- Topeka may send request through inspector
- Phone, email, or snail mail for information
- Offer guidance on compliance
- Determine if informal or formal enforcement is required
