Kansas Clean Diesel Program

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Brief History of DERA

- Diesel engines are cleaner than ever post regulatory activities
- Many older, dirtier diesel engines still in use
- Congress authorized funding for clean diesel activities in the Diesel Emissions Reduction Act (DERA)
- Funding came to states for State Clean Diesel Programs



KS Clean Diesel Program

- Grants for clean diesel activities
- Normally one cycle per year
- 2009 American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA)
- **Current DERA cycle open until 6/30/2010:**

KS Clean Diesel Program - Projects

Only verified technologies are eligible

- Exhaust controls (diesel oxidation catalyst)
- Engine upgrades (tier zero to a higher tier of emission controls)
- Idling Reduction Technologies (auxiliary power units)
- Aerodynamic and Tire Technologies (skirting and low rolling resistant tires)
- Engine or total equipment replacement

Next funding cycle – 2011

- Similar in scope to the current RFP
- Approximately \$300,000 for awards
- Range of awards \$5,000 to \$100,000
- Scoring criteria – Committee uses a point system
 - Project Emission Reduction: Higher the better
 - Matching of funds: Higher the better

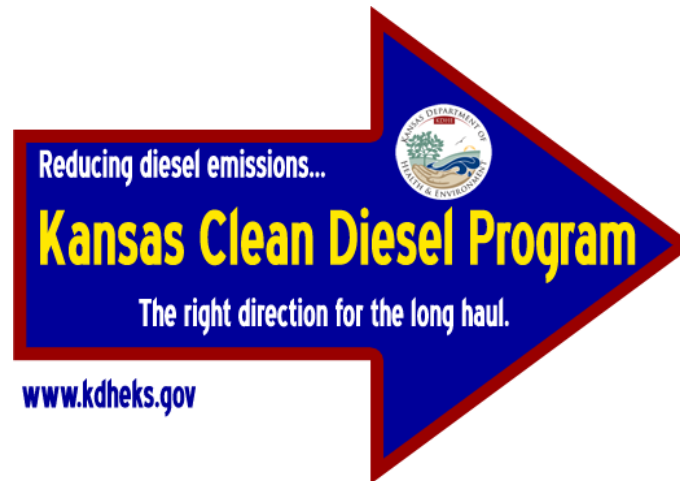
