# Grant Opportunity

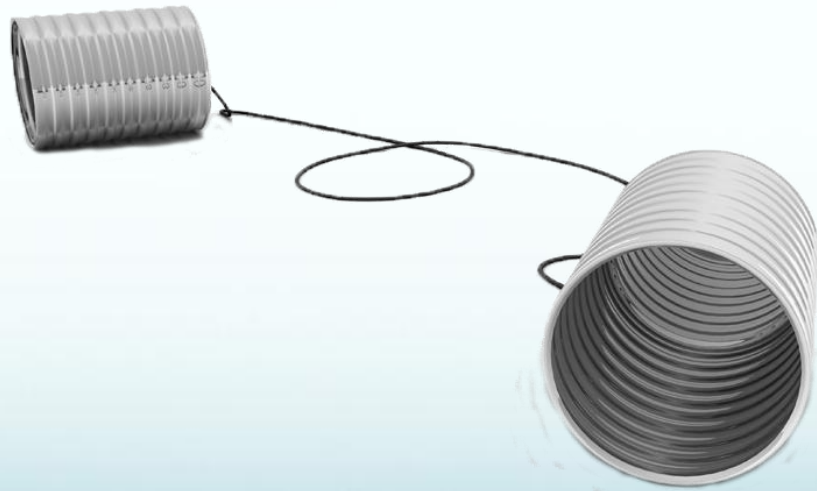
## *Kansas Clean Water Neighbor Program*

- Brochure available at [www.kdheks.gov/nps/downloads/CWN-brochure.pdf](http://www.kdheks.gov/nps/downloads/CWN-brochure.pdf)
- Funds up to \$20,000 (40% of total project cost to be provided by local support)
- Eligibility requirements
  - There must be nonpoint source pollution reduction.
  - There must be an information and education component to the project.
  - The project must score 35 or above on the ranking sheet available on the KDHE, NPS Web site.
  - Local support of 40% of the grant fund must be provided. Local support may be in-kind services.
  - Anyone can apply.
