

Coating Certification Form Template

Sources subject to K.A.R. 28-19-73, *Surface coating of miscellaneous metal parts and products and metal furniture*, may not have to do daily recordkeeping of volatile organic compounds (VOCs) if concentrations of VOCs in paints, coatings, and thinning solvents are below certain thresholds for VOC content (see regulations). To demonstrate you have a compliant coating, the form below must be completed by the manufacturer. Also, you must apply for an exemption with the Kansas Department of Health and Environment. Contact Bureau of Air at 785-296-6024.

Keep the completed form on file at your facility in case you need to show it to an air quality inspector. It is recommended you check with the manufacturer each year to confirm formulations haven't changed for the products you use.
